

# A Letter from our Founder & CEO **RYAN LAMPA**

#### Hello!

I pray this message finds you in the warmth of love and good spirits. I am in awe of the incredible journey we've been on in 2023. Time has flown by, and amid the hustle, I find myself stealing moments to reflect on the countless miracles God worked within our amazing community.

Over this past year, we've had the privilege to walk alongside 35 individuals as they journeyed from the streets to their new homes. Witnessing these transformations is a testament to the power of our collective impact. As we've echoed throughout the year, "All will be well." These 35 individuals have joined us in saying this because of our unified support

Since November of 2008, we haven't missed a single Monday serving our neighbors on the streets. There were moments early on when I thought we needed a break, but the community swiftly rejected that idea. The passion, steadfastness, creativity, and resourcefulness of our volunteers have upheld our mission of sharing Relief, Community, Connection, and Restoration to the most vulnerable in our city. Thousands of volunteer opportunities have delivered over 42,000 meals, 35,000 units of clothing, and over 1000 emergency supplies this year. These volunteers have shared love and light in dark places.

Our outreach team has been working tirelessly, providing an incredible array of resources from food stamps to I.D.s, birth certificates, health care resources, counseling, and rehabilitation connections. Our team has made over 900 crucial connections this past year. This team deserves a round of applause for stepping into this line of work every day.

Our little coffee roasting operation has taken off! What started as a dream to provide jobs has surpassed our expectations. The growth of Paradeisos Coffee Company and the Restoration program has led to the exciting news of opening a brick-and-mortar coffee shop! Stay tuned for opening dates. Soon, we'll be serving you a hot cup of coffee on West End Ave, just a block from where People Loving Nashville began. This year has been a journey of growth, with wonderful additions to our staff and the sad, inevitable goodbyes. We faced challenges head-on, learned valuable lessons, and emerged stronger. We're far from perfect, and we seek grace for our shortcomings. We navigate uncharted territory, finding courage in our staff, volunteers, donors, and those we serve. Together, we are called to grow, and grow we shall.

As we take a bold step into 2024, we have set an audacious goal of supporting 50 individuals into housing, welcoming many more individuals into our Restoration Program, and continuing to consistently hold our Monday Street Outreach, Wednesday encampment support, and Thursday Homefullness Outreach. We ask for you to stand in prayer with us as we extend the hope of Jesus to our neighbors.

Would you join me as we pray for the year ahead? Lord, lift our heads to remember where our help comes from. Guide the steps of our organization, forgive our missteps, and lead us swiftly back to your chosen path. Bless our efforts as we strive to do your work on the streets of Nashville. Be a protector over those who sleep outside, those who feel alone, and those who are afraid, hungry, and lacking even the most basic needs. Bend our hearts towards yours. Thank you for a community that brings us closer to those in need. Bless us, oh Lord, with your presence, for we cannot do this without you.

Thank you for being the heartbeat of People Loving Nashville. As we move into another year, we are confident that all will be well. ## **I BELIEVE IN YOU**

Hope Story from Christian Williams

I believe in You. Do you remember the last time someone spoke these four words to you? Four simple words that together can become life-changing motivation.

Last May, a couple stopped by at Home Church, hoping someone at the church could help. They had no idea this was the location of our headquarters and that one of our team members would be the person they met.

They hadn't slept in 48 hours and were looking for shelter. With their particular situation, there were no shelter options available for them. After spending about an hour talking with them, we determined their most necessary needs and how we could help. We provided them with emergency shelter to hold them over until they received their next paycheck. They made a list of next steps, and we made a check-in plan for accountability and support.

Our parting words were: "We believe in you guys, you guys got this, and we are with you." They replied, "I wish our family would say those words to us." They even asked, "How can strangers believe in us, and yet our family doesn't?"

Extending kindness to a neighbor isn't always about physically giving someone something. Sometimes, the words you choose to speak to someone can breathe life into them and be the greatest gift to another person. Seeing, hearing, and encouraging someone might be the motivation one needed to take their next steps forward.

# RELIEF

During 2023, People Loving Nashville consistently served without missing a week at our Monday Street Outreach, Wednesday Encampment Support, and Thursday Homefullness Outreach. At these outreaches we served over 45,000 meals and over 35,000 units of clothing. Along with providing much-needed relief, a healthy community, and connections to tangible resources. People Loving Nashville supported 35 individuals into housing.













# We share Love and Dignity with the unhoused and most vulnerable of Nashville by bringing Relief, Community, Connection, and Restoration.

# **STREET PROGRAM**

During 2023, we watched the number of individuals experiencing a housing crisis rise by 11%. What does the housing crisis mean? It means someone does not have their own residency, so they live in their car, on the streets, or in a shelter.

At our Monday Street Outreach, we had the largest gatherings we have ever experienced, with a peak night of over 350 individuals served a first-time meal.

No matter where our friends find themselves, they know we will be a consistent place to find relief, enjoy a refreshing drink or savory meal, and find comfort with friends. We pride ourselves on our consistency. Once again, we have finished another year without missing one of our weekly outreaches. We didn't miss a Monday Street Outreach, even with Christmas on Monday, and we didn't miss a Wednesday Encampment Support.


Every Wednesday, our team visits encampments around Nashville and Madison to provide survival supplies needed for each season of the year.

As we build relationships at our Monday Street Outreach & Wednesday Encampment Support, we learn the needs of our neighbors and begin connecting them with additional support. For some, it's helping them with IDs, transportation, or other referrals needed. For others, we begin the Homefullness Journey.




The label that we should all be is HUMAN.

#### **The Impact of Transportation!**

Hope Story from Colleen Wise

"I even got to go to Walgreens and the grocery on the same day!"

"I have a friend who PLN has been working with for years. He typically rides his bike everywhere, and I mean EVERYWHERE. While he says he loves it, I know it's hard on him sometimes.

I recently gave him a 31-day bus pass, and he was so thankful! This week he came to our Monday outreach and told me he just had to thank me in person.

He said the bus pass has been life-changing for him! He was excited that he could now get his basic errands done. He said, "I even got to go to Walgreens and the grocery on the same day!"

It was sweet to see his smile and happiness because he can accomplish errands all at once now that he doesn't have to carry everything he needs to get on his bike. Something that we may not think twice about, like a bus pass, has changed his whole month!"

In 2022, we applied and received two small grants that allowed us to provide individuals with bus passes in 2023. Every person who received a pass made it to doctor's appointments, interviews, work, and the grocery store. Each enjoyed the peace of mind that comes with knowing one can get where one needs to and is not stuck or limited by the barrier of transportation.

By the summer of 2023, We worked with Quickticket to now receive YEAR-LONG bus passes at \$25.00 a pass! (Before this, we were spending \$65 on monthly and \$4 on daily bus passes.)

We are thrilled to find ways to expand the impact of donations we receive and allow more neighbors to experience hope and relief.

# HOPE FEST

October 9th was the launch the first annual HOPEfest! Over 26 organizations linked arms to create one incredible night providing shortterm and long-term resources to approximately 500 unhoused neighbors.

#### **Over 700 meals**

**Over 400 resource bags Over 600 units of clothing/shoes** Over 28 showers Over 500 bus passes **Over 750 resources connections** and 2 housing '101' classes

Additional items our neighbors received were brand-new shoes and hoodies, care packs, free legal advice, yoga classes, "Where to Turn in Nashville" booklet, medical aid care, and raffle prizes!



# HOMEFULINESS PROGRAM

One woman's resilence impacted People Loving Nashville in such a deep way that we launched two additional programs since 2021.

In 2020, we met Jaime, Chris, and their beautiful daughter. It was through meeting and supporting Jamie and her family into housing that we decided to launch our Homefullness Program. What we learned through the launch of our Homefullness Program led us to launch our Restoration Program. Since this launch in 2021, we have supported 102 individuals off the streets and into housing!

#### What does the Homefullness Journey look like?

Our Outreach Specialists start stabilizing needs for food, clothing, survival supplies, documentation, and process challenges. While stabilizing the most immediate needs our Outreach Specialists are building a support system as they help someone navigate off the streets and into housing.

We also provide support for those recently housed throughout Homefullness Outreaches. We provide aid at the transitional and micro-income apartment complexes where many of our friends from the streets find their first stable home. We have become a resource and facilitator of a community gathering among the residents. We are building additional programming and communication with the residents and apartment management.







#### The realities of the streets

How would you describe living on the streets? Jaime replied...

"It's the most terrifying thing in the world whenever you know that your child is homeless and you don't know where the next day's coming. If you don't make it to that shelter in time, you're going to sleep on the streets. They're going to turn you away. Not knowing where the next meal is coming from. Watching her (Jaime's daughter) cry and just feeling completely and utterly useless and just wanting to die. That's what that feels like."

We continued this interview together in tears and also with a celebration of all that Jaime has overcame!

And just like Jesus promised, by His grace, paradise is being built brick by brick. He continues to show up and grow this seed into a dream-building kingdom.






